## Firearms Licence Categories

**Note:** This information sheet does not constitute legal advice and is for general information purposes only. Applicants and licensees are required to understand and comply with the *Firearms Act* 1996 ("the Act") and associated Regulations, which are available on the Tasmanian legislation website — www.legislation.tas.gov.au. This document was prepared in June 2024 based on the relevant legislation at that time.

### To acquire a firearm you need to have a firearms licence of the category appropriate to that firearm (and a permit in respect of that firearm).

The Act includes five firearms licence categories, being:

- Category A firearms licence
- Category B firearms licence
- Category C firearms licence
- Category D firearms licence
- Category H firearms licence

This information sheet provides information in relation to these categories.

#### Category A firearms licence

A Category A firearms licence applies to any -

- I. air rifle; and
- 2. rim-fire rifle, other than self-loading; and
- 3. shotgun, other than pump action or self-loading; and
- 4. shotgun and rim-fire rifle combinations.

A Category A firearms licence authorises the holder to possess or use only a firearm referred to from 1-4 for the particular purpose specified in the licence.

#### Category B firearms licence

A Category B firearms licence applies to any -

- I. muzzle-loading firearm; and
- 2. centre-fire rifle, other than self-loading; and
- 3. shotgun and centre-fire rifle combinations.

A Category B firearms licence authorises the holder to possess or use only a firearm referred to from I-3 for the particular purpose specified in the licence.





#### Category C firearms licence

A Category C firearms licence applies to any -

- self-loading rim-fire rifle with a magazine capacity of no more than 10 rounds of ammunition; and
- 2. self-loading shotgun with a magazine capacity of no more than 5 rounds of ammunition; and
- 3. pump action shotgun with a magazine capacity of no more than 5 rounds of ammunition.

A Category C firearms licence authorises the holder to possess or use only one firearm referred to at I and one firearm referred to at 2 or 3, as specified in the licence and for the particular purpose specified in the licence (except in respect of a Category C firearms licence that is specified as being issued only for the genuine reason of firearms collection).

#### Category D firearms licence

A Category D firearms licence applies to any -

- 1. self-loading centre-fire rifle; and
- 2. self-loading shotgun with a capacity of more than 5 rounds of ammunition; and
- 3. pump action shotgun with a capacity of more than 5 rounds of ammunition; and
- 4. self-loading rim-fire rifle with a magazine capacity of more than 10 rounds of ammunition.

A Category D firearms licence authorises the holder to possess or use only a firearm referred to from I-4 that is specified in the licence for the particular purpose specified in the licence (except in respect of a Category D firearms licence that is specified as being issued only for the genuine reason of firearms collection).

#### Category H firearms licence

- A Category H firearms licence for a purpose other than sport or target shooting applies to any –
  - a. pistol; and
  - b. air pistol.

A Category H firearms licence for a purpose other than sport or target shooting authorises the holder to possess or use only a pistol referred to from 1 (a) and (b) for the particular purpose specified in the licence.

- 2. A Category H firearms licence for sport or target shooting authorises the holder to possess or use any of the following:
  - a. a pistol that does not exceed .38 inch calibre;
  - b. a semi-automatic pistol that has a barrel length of I20 millimetres or more;
  - c. a revolver that has a barrel length of 100 millimetres or more;
  - d. a single-shot pistol that has a barrel length of 100 millimetres or more;
  - e. a pistol that has a magazine capacity of 10 rounds of ammunition or less.

A Category H firearms licence for sport or target shooting authorises the holder, with the approval of the Commissioner, to possess or use a prohibited pistol for the purpose of training for, and participating in, a prescribed event where pistols that have a calibre not exceeding .46 inch may be used.

- 3. A Category H firearms licence for use in the security industry authorises the holder to possess a registered pistol that:
  - a. does not exceed .38 inch calibre or9 millimetre calibre; and
  - b. is owned by, and has as its registrant, the holder's employer; and
  - c. factory-manufactured or factory-loaded ammunition for a registered pistol of the kind referred at 3 (a) and (b).
